

Civil War Photography Contest

Sponsored by Calagaz Printing & Blakeley State Park

Commemorating the 144th anniversary of the last battle of the Civil War fought at Blakeley April 9, 1865 and recognizing 53 years of service to the Gulf Coast by Calagaz Printing.

Dates: Photos to be shot **April 4-5, 2009** at Blakeley State Park Civil War reenactment and submitted by **April 20, 2009**. Winners to be announced at the Calagaz Family Fun Day **May 2, 2009**.

Divisions and Awards:

I. Action Category: Best photos of action by infantry, artillery, or cavalry during reenactment.

II. Military Camp Scene: Best photos of Civil War encampments depicting preparing for battle, cooking, leisure time etc.

III. Interaction of reenactors with public: Best photos showing interaction of reenactors with spectators either children or adults. May include demonstration of weapons.

Awards for Categories I, II, and III and Best of Show

Best of Show: \$100 Cash award by Blakeley Park

First Place for each: 16x20 Canvas Print by Calagaz valued at \$100 each.

Second Place for each: Two tickets to Blakeley boat tour of Tensaw-Mobile Delta on its August 2009 "walk on". (Date to be set.) Value \$44

Third Place for each: Four tickets to Blakeley Bluegrass Festival Oct. 3, 2009 valued at \$40.

Contest Rules:

1. There is no entry fee for the contest.
2. All photos must be made during the Blakeley Civil War Battle Event April 4-5, 2009 at Blakeley State Park on Hwy. 225 about 5 miles north of Spanish Fort. (Admission to event is \$10 adults, \$5 kids).

3. Entries must be color prints minimum size of 8x10, maximum size 8x12, glossy finish. Should not be matted.
4. Entries may be submitted to either Calagaz or Blakeley Park. An entry form must be attached to each entry. Entries must be received by 5 p.m. April 20, 2009. No faxed or e-mailed entries will be accepted. Calagaz is located at 90 Springdale Blvd., Mobile, Al. Blakeley Park's mailing address is P.O. Box 7279, Spanish Fort, Al 36577.
5. All entries become the property of Historic Blakeley State Park and may be used by the Park in its promotions. Contestant is responsible for ensuring permission for such use by any person other than a re-enactor who is pictured in the photograph entered.
6. Each entry must be accompanied by a completed official entry registration form. Multiple entries are allowed.
7. Winners to be determined by an independent panel of judges selected by Blakeley Park and will be announced at the Calagaz Family Fun Day May 2, 2009 and to the press.
